

Sailboat Napkins and Straw Toppers



To make the straw toppers you will need to print out this sheet onto thick paper and then cut around the outer edge of the topper (right), making the holes with a hole punch; or use the topper outline (right) as a trace, and then cut the shape from thick card. Make the holes with a punch.

Using the sailboat trace (right): cut out the boat, sail, flag from the coloured parts of the napkin. Glue the boat to the topper then slide onto a straw.

To make the napkin ring, you will need to cut a slice from a toilet tissue inner tube, and then wrap it with paper cut from the plainer part of the napkin. Add glue to the inside to hold the paper in place.

Using the sailboat trace as before, cut out the sails, boat and flag from the coloured parts of the napkin. Glue onto the napkin ring.

This project can be completed even if you do not have sailboat napkins. Plain red or blue napkins and a few scraps of paper or fabric can be used.

Use the straw topper trace to create a range of different topper: trees for Christmas, spiders for Halloween, eggs for Easter and bells or bows for a Wedding.
